The aim of the Art Department is to enthuse, to inspire and to develop an enjoyment of art and the creative processes. The department offers a wide range of impressive facilities, including a ceramic studio, photographic darkroom, Sixth Form studio and two art studios.

We start by developing our pupils' ability to draw from observation and imagination, gradually broadening their artistic experience by introducing them to new activities.

All Lower School students learn drawing, painting, black and white photography, sculpture (including clay), graphic design and a range of printmaking and ICT skills.

Upper School students develop their abilities in these activities as well as having the opportunity to study photography, screen printing, animation, video art and life-drawing.
